- · Use of substances is causing relationship problems
- · Denial or quilt around the frequency of substances being consumed
- · Words or actions under the influence are constantly regretted
- Injury or legal trouble occurs under the influence of a substance
- · Financial troubles exist due to use of a substance

Prevent substance abuse by taking an active role in both your own life as well as those around you. Positive examples as Marines, education through our substance abuse program, and a positive organizational climate will provide the foundation to prevent substance abuse from occurring.
